1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** A European Open meeting organised by the NG Road Racing Club held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Drivers must be registered members of the NG Road Racing Club and a holder of a valid current ACU or Scottish ACU Competition Licence for Road Racing. Junior class is open to riders aged 16 years and under on 1st January 2010. Entries will be accepted from other European FMNs Licence holders subject to production of written start permission and proof of Insurance to FIM minimum standards. Licences must be produced when signing on.
4. **THE COURSE:** Brands Hatch Indy is 1.198 miles in length. It is situated on the A29, well signposted from M25 J3, in Kent.
5. **ENTRIES:** The Club reserves the right to refuse entry, abandon, cancel or postpone the Meeting or alter the programme of events or awards. Non-members should enclose the annual membership fee of £20 (Juniors £10) or single event membership fee of £10. **All fees listed are per day except for 250GP ACU National Championship & NG Cup.**
Closing Date: 05/03/10. Whilst we endeavour to accommodate all riders, we cannot guarantee your place in an over subscribed event.
First Class: Solos £120, Juniors £100, Sidecars £130 (all classes £25 discount for Scottish / Irish / European residents & licence holders).
 250GP ACU National Championship & NG Cup £170 per meeting (£100 for Scottish / Irish / European residents & licence holders).
Subsequent Classes: £75. Newcomer race (Sunday Only) £30.
Payment: Cheque or postal order made payable to NGRRC OR Credit/Debit card, credit card payments subject to a fee of £2.00. Please enclose SAE. Entries received after closing date will incur a £15 (£20 on race day) late entry fee which is non refundable. Any unpaid cheque will attract an additional charge of £20.

Cancellations: If a rider has a genuine reason for not attending and informs the secretary of the meeting in writing and this is received along with passes etc at least 24 hours before the day of the meeting, a credit note towards another meeting may be issued. The value of the credit note will be entirely at the club's discretion.
6. **INSURANCE:** The Organisers undertake to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him against any third party claims arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor, or mechanic. There will be no weekly benefit payment.
7. **LIMITATIONS:** Maximum number of starters will be – **Practice:** Solos 57 / Sidecars 36. **Race:** Solos 38 / Sidecars 24.
8. **CHANGE OF MACHINE OR RIDER:** Either the rider/passenger or machine, but not both, may be changed on a request in writing to the Entries Secretary and not later than 09:30 on the day of the meeting.
9. **TECHNICAL INSPECTION:** Between 07:00 and 09:00 only. Riders are to present themselves for inspection fully clothed in their leathers etc as for racing.
10. **RACE OFFICE:** Open from 07:00 Saturday, 08:00 Sunday. It is the riders duty to ensure that he/she has passed technical inspection and signed on in the race office in time for their class practice.
11. **PRACTICE:** Saturday and Sunday, as advised and qualified by Final Instructions. Riders must complete at least two laps of practice before they will be allowed to race.
12. **PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:** Racing will commence as soon as practice is complete. It is the rider's duty to ensure they are in the assembly area in good time. All races are preceded by a non-competitive warm up lap; any rider arriving late for the warm up lap will start from the back of the grid and may be prevented from racing. All qualifying & newcomer races will be 10 laps. Finals will be 12 laps. Open Final will be 15 laps.
13. **GRID POSITIONS:** Grid positions for the first race (Qualifier) will be determined by championship positions, for the first ten grid positions, with the remainder by order of receipt of entry up to the closing date of the event. Entries received after closing date will not qualify for seeded grid positions. When the closing date has passed the entrants for each race will be condensed to absorb any empty grid slots retained for championship positions. For the second race (Championship Final) grid positions are determined according to results of the first race. Non finishers may race in the championship Final but will be placed at the back of the grid. In the event of any class being oversubscribed we may accommodate riders by running 2 qualification heats and two finals (Main & B), subject to entries. The grid positions for the 'Main' Final will be a full grid of an equal number of the top finishing qualifiers from Heats 1 and 2. Remaining riders will compete in the 'B' Final which is a non championship race.
Phoenix Open – Grid positions will be determined by timed qualifying. In the event of the class being over subscribed we may run two timed qualifying sessions and two finals (Main & B). The grid positions for the Main Final will be a full grid of the fastest riders from the qualifying sessions, if conditions are deemed changeable across the two qualifying sessions, grid positions for the 'Main' Final will be a full grid of an equal number of the top finishing qualifiers from Qualifying 1 and 2. The remaining riders will compete (in qualifying order) in the 'B' Final (no championship points). Riders who fail to register a Qualifying time, may apply to the Clerk of the Course, (Race Control) to be placed at the back of the grid for the Final, subject to the discretion of the
