1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:** A European Open meeting organised by the NG Road Racing Club held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary Regulations, together with any Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made.

3. **ELIGIBILITY:** Drivers must be registered members of the NG Road Racing Club and a holder of a valid current ACU or Scottish ACU Competition Licence for Road Racing. Junior class is open to riders aged 16 years and under on 1st January 2010. Entries will be accepted from other European FMNs Licence holders subject to production of written start permission and proof of Insurance to FIM minimum standards. Licences must be produced when signing on.
4. **THE COURSE:** Pembrey Circuit is 1.456 miles in length. It is on the A484 between Llanelli and Camarthen in Dyfed, S Wales.
5. **ENTRIES:** The Club reserves the right to refuse entry, abandon, cancel or postpone the Meeting or alter the programme of events or awards. Non-members should enclose the annual membership fee of £20 (Juniors £10) or single event membership fee of £10.
Closing Date: 14/05/10. Whilst we endeavour to accommodate all riders, we cannot guarantee your place in an over subscribed event.
First Class & Prince of Pembrey Anniversary races Solos & Sidecars £225 for 3 days racing, (Juniors £185) to include 2 days of NG Champs + One day of "Prince of Pembrey Anniversary races" for all entrants. - (£25 weekend discount for Scottish / Irish / European residents & licence holders).
 One or two day entrants pay £90 per day.
 250GP ACU National Championship & NG Cup £170 per meeting (£100 for Scottish / Irish / European residents & licence holders). + Extra £45 for Prince of Pembrey races.
 ACU Suzuki GSX-R Trophy £150 per round. 1 Round (2 races) held on each day.
Subsequent Classes: £45 per class per day (Sat. & Mon) Newcomer races 2 Rounds £45.
Payment: Cheque or postal order made payable to NGRRC OR Credit/Debit card, credit card payments subject to a fee of £2.00. Please enclose SAE. Entries received after closing date will incur a £15 (£20 on race day) non refundable late entry fee. Unpaid cheques will attract an additional charge of £20.

Cancellations: If a rider has a genuine reason for not attending and informs the secretary of the meeting in writing and this is received along with passes etc at least 24 hours before the day of the meeting, a credit note towards another meeting may be issued. The value of the credit note will be entirely at the club's discretion.
6. **INSURANCE:** The Organisers undertake to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him against any third party claims arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor, or mechanic. There will be no weekly benefit payment.
7. **LIMITATIONS:** Maximum number of starters will be – **Practice:** Solos 58 / Sidecars 39. **Race:** Solos 39 / Sidecars 26.
8. **CHANGE OF MACHINE OR RIDER:** Either the rider/passenger or machine, but not both, may be changed on a request in writing to the Entries Secretary and not later than 09:30 on the day of the meeting.
9. **TECHNICAL INSPECTION:** Between 07:00 and 09:00 only. Riders are to present themselves for inspection fully clothed in their leathers etc as for racing.
10. **RACE OFFICE:** Open from 07:00 Saturday, 08:00 Sunday. It is the riders duty to ensure that he/she has passed technical inspection and signed on in the race office in time for their class practice.
11. **PRACTICE:** Saturday, Sunday and Monday, as advised and qualified by Final Instructions. Riders must complete at least two laps of practice before they will be allowed to race.
12. **PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:** Racing will commence as soon as practice is complete. It is the rider's duty to ensure they are in the assembly area in good time. All races are preceded by a non-competitive warm up lap; any rider arriving late for the warm up lap will start from the back of the grid and may be prevented from racing.
Saturday & Monday: All qualifying & newcomer races will be 8 laps. Finals will be 9 laps. Open Final will be 12 laps.
Sunday: Anniversary races Timed qualifying and up to 3 Races for all.
13. **GRID POSITIONS:** Grid positions for the first race (Qualifier) will be determined by championship positions, for the first ten grid positions, with the remainder by order of receipt of entry up to the closing date of the event. Entries received after closing date will not qualify for seeded grid positions. When the closing date has passed the entrants for each race will be condensed to absorb any empty grid slots retained for championship positions. For the second race (Championship Final) grid positions are determined according to results of the first race. Non finishers may race in the championship Final but will be placed at the back of the grid. In the event of any class being oversubscribed we may accommodate riders by running 2 qualification heats and two finals (Main & B), subject to entries. The grid positions for the 'Main' Final will be a full grid of an equal number of the top finishing qualifiers from Heats 1 and 2. Remaining riders will compete in the 'B' Final which is a non championship race.
Phoenix Open & SUNDAY PRINCE OF PEMBREY – Grid positions will be determined by timed qualifying. In the event of the class being over subscribed we may run two timed qualifying sessions and two finals (Main & B). The grid positions for the Main

final will be a full grid of the fastest riders from the qualifying sessions, if conditions are deemed changeable across the two qualifying sessions. grid positions for the 'Main' Final will be a full grid of an equal number of the top finishing qualifiers from Qualifying 1 and 2. The remaining riders will compete (in qualifying order) in the 'B' Final (no championship points). Riders who fail to register a Qualifying time, may apply to the Clerk of the Course, (Race Control) to be placed at the back of the grid for the Final, subject to the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Where two finals are being run (Main and B), riders who fail to register a time during qualifying, may apply to the Clerk of the Course to be placed at the back of the grid of the B final. (Space permitting). The Clerk of the Course' decision will be final and not open to appeal.

ACU Suzuki GSX-R Trophy – See separate championship conditions.

- METHOD OF START:** All Events are started by means of a Clutch Start. Races will be started by lights or lowering of the national flag. Any rider who is adjudged to have made a false start, including starting from a position other than their allotted grid position, will incur a time penalty.
- FINISH OF RACES:** The chequered flag will be shown as the winner finishes the race and each rider crossing the line after the winner will be flagged off. To be classed as a finisher, a rider must cross the line within 2 minutes after the winner and must have completed 75% of the race distance. A last lap flag will be displayed.
- NEW LICENCE HOLDERS:** New Clubmen licence holders are required to wear an orange jacket until receiving all of the necessary signatures on their record card.

600cc Open	Solo machines 401 - 600cc 4 cylinder (including Kawasaki's 636), 675cc 3 cylinder & 750cc 2 cylinder. Slick tyres permitted.
250GP ACU National & NG Cup	250cc Two Stroke GP Prototype machines as per championship and registration conditions
Powerbike	Four-stroke machines 700cc and above. Slick tyres permitted.
Open	Solo machines 125cc GP and above (excluding F125 and Juniors). Slick tyres permitted.
Sound of Thunder	Four-stroke single, twin and triple machines. Slick tyres permitted.
Mini Twins	Solo four-stroke, twin cylinder machines up to 650cc. Refer to Mini Twin regulations
700cc Streetstocks	Solo Machines 401 - 700cc (inc up to 750cc twin cylinder four stroke) as per series rules. Metzeler Control Tyres
1300cc Streetstocks	Solo Machines 701 - 1300cc (exc up to 750cc twin cylinder four stroke) as per series rules. Metzeler Control Tyres
1300cc Pre Injection – Pre 2001	Solo Machines up to 1300cc, not fuel injected and manufactured before 2001. Slick tyres permitted.
Newcomers	Solo machines in two classes, up to 400cc and over 400cc. Entrants must hold a Clubman licence, be required to wear an Orange Vest and not have held an ACU licence before 1 st January 2009. May be entered as a second ride only. Slick tyres allowed if licence permits.
ACU Suzuki GSX-R Trophy	Solo four-stroke 600cc Suzuki GSX-R machines. See www.gsxtrophy.co.uk for details.
Sidecar	Open class for all three-wheeler outfits, with a separate class for F2 machines
Up to 600cc SUNDAY ONLY	Open class for solo machines up to 600cc 4 cylinder (including Kawasaki's 636), 675cc 3 cylinder & 750cc 2 cylinder. Slick tyres permitted.
Over 600cc SUNDAY ONLY	Open class for solo machines over 600cc 4 cylinder, excluding Kawasaki's 636, 675cc 3 cylinder & 750cc 2 cylinder. Slick tyres permitted.

- TIMING:** Personal AMB TransX260 transponders are to be fitted to all machines. Transponder numbers are to be quoted on each entry form. Machines not fitted with a transponder will not be allowed to compete. Entries received without a transponder number will be returned. Please fit transponder, if possible, near headstock of machine.
- POINTS:** Points awarded based on FIM World Championship system. 1st 25, 2nd 20, 3rd 16, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
ACU Suzuki GSX-R Trophy – See separate championship conditions.
- AWARDS:** Awards will only be presented on production of ACU licence. Prize money should be collected from the race office before the end of the day. The race office closes 30 minute after the end of the final race of the day. Monies not collected on the race weekend may be donated to the NG Marshal's Fund.

- COURSE CONDUCT:** Riders must only enter and leave the circuit at designated points. Riding of motorised paddock bikes, bicycles or scooters is prohibited. Crash helmets must be worn at all times while riding. Dangerous riding or unsporting conduct will result in disqualification and / or a fine. Under 16 year olds, unless a competitor, are not permitted in the pit lane.
