As ever at this time of the year, with this meeting hosting the tenth and eleventh rounds of the fourteen round season anyone who has half an eye on one of the coveted class championships is in a tricky situation. Do you risk all, and keep pushing for points.....or do you sit back and see what your challengers are doing?...time will tell. Each rider will treat this round differently.

The Anglesey Coastal Circuit is one that most riders love, but being hung out on the top of North Wales the weather can play a huge part in the weekend and therefore your bike set up.

In recent years it has seen the championship hopes of several riders take a knock.... Sorry to remind you guys (you know who you are....), but this circuit can bite !!

The nimble and fast 250 two stroke GP derived bikes and almost perfectly suited to the circuit layout, so we expect for great action with three proven champions in Ant Hodson, Philip Atkinson and Dan Jackson vying for the 2017 title. Keep an eye too on Simon

Hunt who heads the NG Cup series with an impressive 2017 record of ten wins from fourteen starts.

The big superbikes are fast here, but can be a handful around the top reaches of the circuit including the infamous corkscrew. Josh Day continues his rich vein of form on his ZX10 Kawasaki, but Peter Carr on another ZX10, Chris Pope on his R1, Michael Blank also R1 mounted plus Suzuki riders Nick Williamson and Sean Hennessey will be hoping to take the fight to Day

As I said the full gamut of race bikes will be out on this stunning Anglesey coastal circuit. Streetstock, Pre Injections, GP45's, Desmo Due Ducati's, Mini Twins, Super Twins, Sound of Thunder.....There is something for every racer and race watcher.....

Moto E

NG is again hosting the UK rounds of the European Moto E series for the innovative all electric powered bikes. Multiple Moto E winner Daley Mathison has been the man to beat on the Nottingham University bike for the last two seasons, but that irks the Chinese Zongshen Team. Could this be the meeting that Zongshen gets back onto the top step of the podium. Power conservation for the rider will be tough here with Anglesey's great elevation changes. The series has been here for the last couple of years so they do at least have data

Anglesey Circuit

The circuit is situated on the Isle of Anglesey, between Rhosneiger and Abberfaw. Follow the A55 to J5 then take the A4080. Just follow the brown circuit signs **Sat Nav : LL63 5TF**

Technical Inspection	7:00am	8:00am	See the bikes being checked by the Scrutineers, and wander round the pits
Free Practice	9:00am	9:00am	Watch the riders get familiar with the circuit in free practice.
Qualifying Races	10:30am	10:00am	The competitors race for grid positions for the finals.
Championship Races	14:00pm	13:30pm	Now it gets serious.....Championship points, trophies and glory at stake.

What's on track

Up to 20 NG Road Racing championship races each day split into qualifiers and finals for each of the classes. That means some 8 hours of on track action each day. I suggest you get in nice and early, take a wander around the paddock and soak up the atmosphere as the riders go through technical inspection and free practice, then take to the track in anger for the qualifiers in seeded championship order. The main finals kick off early afternoon when all the championship points and prizes are contested.
