ELIGIBILITY:

Riders must be registered members of the NG Road Racing Club and a holder of a valid current ACU or Scottish ACU Competition Licence for Road Racing. Junior class is open to riders aged 16 years and under on 1st January 2017. Entries will be accepted from other European FMNs Licence holders subject to production of written start permission and proof of Insurance to at least FIM minimum standards. Licences **must** be produced when signing on.

ENTRIES:

The Club reserves the right to refuse entry, abandon, cancel or postpone the Meeting or alter the programme of events or awards. Non-members should enclose the annual membership fee of £25 (Juniors £10) or single event membership fee of £10. **All fees listed are per day except for 250/125 GP ACU National Championship.**

NOTE: To guarantee that you and your sponsors are printed in the Event Programme, your entry must be received no later than 7 days prior to the Event.

Entry fees: The entry fees for the season are detailed in the individual Event Entry Forms. Cheques and card payments will be taken 2 weeks prior to meeting.

Cancellations: If a rider has a genuine reason for not attending and informs the secretary of the meeting in writing and this is received along with passes etc at least 24 hours before the day of the meeting, a credit note towards another meeting may be issued. The value of the credit note will be entirely at the Club's discretion.

Race Numbers: will be reserved up to two weeks prior to the meeting.

Late Entries: (those received 10 days prior to the meeting or later), subject to space in the event, a surcharge of £15 will be added to the entry fee. 7 days prior to the meeting will be the cut-off date for entry in the race programme.

INSURANCE:

The Organisers undertake to insure each rider and passenger, indemnifying them against any third party claims arising out of the races or official practice, excluding claims by other riders or passengers, entrant, sponsor, or mechanic, in accordance with the scheme of insurance set out in the current ACU Handbook.

CHANGE OF MACHINE OR RIDER:

Either the rider/passenger or machine, but not both, may be changed on a request in writing to the Entries Secretary and not later than 09:30 on the day of the meeting.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

Riders are to present their machine and themselves for inspection fully clothed in their leathers etc as for racing. **See final instructions for times.**

RACE OFFICE:

Open from 07:00 Saturday, 08:00 Sunday. It is the rider's duty to ensure that he/she has passed technical inspection and signed on in the race office in time for their class practice.

PRACTICE: Saturday and Sunday, as per allocation in Race Office when signing on (see Final Instructions). Practice sessions will be a minimum of 10 minutes in duration as per ACU Handbook.

PROGRAMME OF EVENTS:

Racing will commence as soon as practice is complete. It is the rider's duty to ensure they are in the assembly area in good time. All races are preceded by a non-competitive warm up lap; any rider arriving late for the warm up lap will start from the back of the grid (if space permits) and may be prevented from racing. Due to entry levels and time constraints, some classes may be combined on the same grid. See overleaf for Race Laps.

GRID POSITIONS:

All races apart from the Open and 250/125. There are two races per day. Race 1 (non point scoring) – Grid positions will be determined by championship positions for the first ten up to 10 days prior to the meeting and by order of receipt of entry for the rest. If a race is oversubscribed timed qualifying may replace the first race.

Race 2 (point scoring) - Grid positions are determined according to results of the first race or by timed qualifying. Non finishers in Race 1 may race in Race 2 and should report to the Assembly Area for their grid position allocation.

In the case of timed qualifying, non qualifiers / riders who have failed to set a time should report to the race office for further instruction.

Open - One day meetings - Qualifying Practice and 1 Race. Two day meetings - Saturday = Qualifying Practice and 1 Race. Sunday = 2 races. Race 1 grids from Qualifying Practice, Races 2 and 3 based on results of Race 1 and 2 respectively. All 3 races point scoring.

250/125s see separate championship conditions.

START & FINISH OF RACES:

Races will be started by lights or lowering of the national flag. Any rider who is adjudged to have made a false start, including starting from a position other than their allotted grid position, will incur a time penalty. The chequered flag will be shown as the winner finishes the race and each rider crossing the line after the winner will be flagged off. To be classed as a finisher, a rider must cross the line within 2 minutes of the winner and must have completed 75% of the race distance. A last lap flag will be displayed.

NEW LICENCE HOLDERS:

All Novice/Intermediate Novice licence holders are required to wear an orange jacket at all times while on circuit.

TIMING:

Personal MyLaps X2 transponders or AMB TranX260 are to be fitted to all machines. Transponder numbers are to be quoted on each entry form. Machines not fitted with a transponder will not be allowed to compete. Entries received without a transponder number will be returned. Transponders are available to hire, please write 'HIRE' in the transponder box.

POINTS:

Points awarded based on FIM World Championship system. 1st 25, 2nd 20, 3rd 16, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

AWARDS:

Awards will only be presented on production of competition licence. Prize money should be collected from the race office before the end of the day. The race office closes 30 minutes after the end of the final race of the day. Monies not collected on the race weekend may be donated to the NG Marshal's Fund.

ADMISSION:

Each accepted solo rider will receive three personal passes. Sidecar competitors will receive six passes. ALL extra persons arriving with a competitor will be charged admission. Off track, there is a strict speed limit of 20mph. Animals are NOT permitted at any time. Whilst we welcome children and families, **children must be supervised at all times and are prohibited from riding bicycles and scooters in the paddock whilst the race circuit is live.**

COURSE CONDUCT:

Riders must only enter and leave the circuit at designated points. Riding of motorised paddock bikes, is prohibited. Crash helmets must be worn at all times while riding. Dangerous riding or unsporting conduct will result in disqualification and / or a fine. **Under 16 year olds, unless a competitor, are not permitted in the pit lane.**

Formula 125	All production based machines up to 125cc (inc 80cc GP). Any moulded treaded tyre. Slick tyres not permitted.
F400	Production based machines - 250cc two stroke, 400cc four stroke. As per ACU Handbook rules, Any moulded treaded tyre, no slicks.
Open 500cc	Solo machines up to 500cc (excluding F125 machines). Slick tyres permitted.
600cc Open	Solo machines 401 - 600cc 4 cylinder, Kawasaki 636 pre-2007, 675cc 3 cylinder & 750cc 2 cylinder. Slick tyres permitted. Open to 125GP machines, the 250GP Championship includes Moto3 machines.
250 / 125 GP ACU National Championship – including NG Trophy	250GP ACU National Championship including NG Trophy. Open to 125GP machines, the 250GP Championship.
Powerbike	Four-stroke machines 700cc and above. Slick tyres permitted.
Open	Solo machines 125cc GP and above (excluding F125 and Juniors). Slick tyres permitted.
Sound of Thunder	Four-stroke single, twin and triple machines. Slick tyres permitted.

Newcomers	Solo machines in three classes. Entrants will be required to wear an Orange Vest and not have held an ACU Road Race licence before 1 st January 2016. May be entered as a second ride only. Slick tyres allowed if licence permits.
