



## *NG Road Racing and Castle Combe Circuit Training Academy*

**2019 BRA/CTC Course for all new ACU Road Race Licence Applicants -  
Venue – Castle Combe Circuit - SN14 7EY**

**To be held on the following dates in 2019**

**Wed 24<sup>th</sup> April, / Wed 22<sup>nd</sup> May, / Wed 19<sup>th</sup> June, / Wed 31<sup>st</sup> July**

As part of the ACU's ongoing policy of rider development and education, and in line with requirements as laid down in the 2019 ACU Handbook, all first time applicants for a Road Race Licence \* & applicants whose licences have lapsed for more than 5 years must undergo a **Classroom Training Course (CTC) & Basic Riding Ability** assessment. (BRA)

\*Lapsed licence holders who previously held a full Clubman or above licence may only have to sit the CTC element, contact me for confirmation

The purpose of the classroom course is to ensure that you understand the basic safety and organisational requirements to participate in road racing.

Before any new licence can be issued, you must satisfactorily attend the course and pass the multiple-choice test

In addition to the CTC all new applicants for a Road Race Licence must undergo a Basic Rider Ability assessment to show you have the ability to ride a motorcycle to a safe standard while on track.

To take part in this course you must have the use of a motorcycle, and a full set of protective clothing including one piece leathers, a helmet bearing an ACU gold stamp, suitable boots and gloves. \*\*You can ride any motorcycle for the Basic Riding Ability assessment; it does not have to be a Racing Motorcycle. The motorcycle should be road worthy and should not have any race numbers showing during the test.

\*\*If you do not have a current Full DVLA "Grade A" road licence, you are limited to 600cc 4 cylinder, 673 triple, 750 twin machines. If under 18 further restrictions may apply.

The ACU Training Course and Basic Rider Assessment course is organised by NG and Castle Combe Circuit and held at the Circuit, post code SN14 7EY, on the dates above.
