

Annex C V2 – Covid 19

April 2021

To be read in addition to the Supplementary Regulations, Final Instructions and Auto Cycle Union Risk Assessment issued for Brands Hatch on

16th to 18th April 2021

If you live in an area that is “locked down” you should not attend this event. Contact the Race Office to cancel your entry.

Face Masks must be worn while queuing to enter and within ALL buildings and covered areas at the event venue without exception. This includes but is not limited to Restaurant, Race Office, Marshals Administration, Technical Inspection, Medical Centre, Marshals posts, Venue Office, Toilets.

- 1. Government Guidelines Statement:** This event takes place with the condition that all current Government Guidelines and laws will be strictly adhered to including but not limited to: Increased hand washing, high levels of personal hygiene covering sneezing, coughing, before and after eating and handling food, Social Distancing (the 2 metre rule), gatherings of more than 6 people which is currently LAW and not guidelines, a maximum of 2 households – outdoors, regional restrictions of movement and travel.
- 2. Additional Signage:** You must observe all signage, markings, directions and temporary safety systems put in place, which you may not be familiar with at this race venue.
- 3. Traveling:** Traveling to and from the venue must only take place if permitted to do so according to your current local Government laws and guidelines and considering possible restrictions of movement. **Vehicle sharing** must be avoided with anyone outside of your regular household members/established support bubble.
- 4. Self Contained:** All riders, their family and teams must aim to be as self contained as reasonably practicable for the duration of the event. Tools and equipment must not be shared between teams. Social bubbles must be formed per team and strictly adhered to.
- 5. PPE:** All riders, their family and teams are responsible for providing their own PPE which must be worn in accordance with current Government Guidelines and as stated previously within this annex. You must ensure you have enough to last the full duration of the event and be aware of the Government/matrix manufacturer recommendations for use per item. Ensure you include hand sanitiser in the absence of mains water within your unit/pit area. You **will** require face masks at this event. The Club will be responsible for supplying officials PPE only however, it is recommended you provide your own face coverings due to personal preference and suitability of fit.
- 6. Signing on/Race office/Registration:** The office is not to be used as a social gathering point. No face mask – no entry. Results will be presented in the window of offices and you should take a photo from outside the office using your own hand held devices. Paper results will not be available.
- 7. Technical Inspection and sound testing:** Technical Inspection will be from 1630 Friday, (see separate Technical Inspection Process sheet), then from 0700 Saturday and 0745 Sunday. All machines must be sound tested prior to entering the circuit for the first time, random testing will also take place throughout the weekend.

- 8. Paddock parking/Space.** You must park and set up responsibly ensuring Social Distancing can be maintained at all times. Allow ample space between vehicles/awnings and ensure no one occupies the spaces between you and the team next to you. As a guide you must ensure with vehicle doors open, a space greater than 2 meters must be retained all around your unit. If someone occupies a space around you, and is within your 2 metre margin, you must politely ask them to move and report this immediately.
- 9. On Track Responsibilities:** Should you fall from your machine while on track, if you are able you must pick your own machine up and move it to the safety barriers, withdrawing yourself to a safe place behind the barriers as quickly as possible. You must remain with your machine. A recovery truck will collect you at the end of the session/race. Please ensure you assist where possible by loading your own machine. If you break down around the track, follow the same rules, by withdrawing to a safe place as quickly as possible, assist the recovery crew when they arrive and in all circumstances, follow their advice and instructions.
- 10. Summary:** It is a condition of entry, that you are fully aware of current Government LAWS and Guidelines at the time of the event before you set off from home. As a community, NG Road Racing will adopt a self policing policy whereby, it is everyone's responsibility to ensure the rules set out by our Government, the Auto Cycle Union, Circuit Owners and NG Road Racing are being followed. Anyone continually not behaving in accordance with those rules, will be asked to leave the venue.
- 11. If you or any of your social bubble/team/family develop symptoms of Covid 19 while at the venue, you must all leave the venue immediately. It is important you notify NG Road Racing via phone/text about your situation. The numbers are: Race Office 07580 094577 or Steve Bostock 07967 681639. Leave a message if there is no answer. Do not under any circumstances visit any office on site, you must not visit the Medical Centre.**
- 12. If you or any of your social bubble/team/family develop symptoms of Covid 19 during the lead up to the event, i.e within 14 days - **you must not attend**. Notify NG Road Racing of your situation immediately and you will be given a full race entry refund.**
