

# Covid 19 – From 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021

June 2021

**To be read in addition to the Supplementary Regulations, Final Instructions and Auto Cycle Union Risk Assessment issued for CASTLE COMBE on**

**4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

**Face Masks must be worn while queuing to enter and within ALL buildings and covered areas at the event venue without exception. This includes but is not limited to Restaurant, Race Office, Marshals Administration, Technical Inspection, Medical Centre, Marshals posts, Venue Office, Toilets.**

- 1. Government Guidelines:** This event takes place with the condition that all current Government Guidelines will be strictly adhered to including but not limited to: Increased hand washing, high levels of personal hygiene covering sneezing, coughing, before and after eating and handling food, Social Distancing
- 2. Additional Signage:** You must observe all signage, markings, directions and temporary safety systems put in place, which you may not be familiar with at this race venue.
- 3. Self Contained:** All riders, their family and teams must aim to be as self contained as reasonably practicable for the duration of the event. Tools and equipment must not be shared between teams. Social bubbles must be formed per team and adhered to.
- 4. PPE:** All competitors and their essential helpers are responsible for providing their own PPE which must be worn in accordance with current Government Guidelines. You must ensure you have enough to last the full duration of the event and be aware of the Government/manufacture recommendations for use per item. Ensure you include hand sanitiser in the absence of mains water within your unit/pit area. You **will** require face masks at this event. The Club will hold a supply of PPE for officials only however, it is recommended you provide your own face coverings due to personal preference and suitability of fit.
- 5. Signing on/Race office/Registration:** The office is not to be used as a social gathering point. No face mask – no entry. Results will be presented in the window of offices and you should take a photo from outside the office using your own hand held devices. Paper results will not be available.
- 6. Technical Inspection and sound testing:** Technical Inspection will be from 1630 Friday, (see separate Technical Inspection Process sheet), then from 0700 Saturday and 0745 Sunday. All machines must be sound tested prior to entering the circuit for the first time, Friday 4<sup>th</sup> commencing at 0800, Saturday from 0830. Random testing will also take place throughout the weekend.
- 7. On Track Responsibilities:** Should you fall from your machine while on track, if you are able you must pick your own machine up and move it to the safety barriers, withdrawing yourself to a safe place behind the barriers as quickly as possible. You must remain with your machine. A recovery truck will collect you at the end of the session/race. Please ensure you assist where possible by loading your own machine. If you break down around the track, follow the same rules, by withdrawing to a safe place as quickly as possible, assist the recovery crew when they arrive and in all circumstances, follow their advice and instructions.

- 8. Summary:** It is a condition of entry, that you are fully aware of current Government Guidelines at the time of the event before you set off from home. As a community, NG Road Racing will adopt a self policing policy whereby, it is everyone's responsibility to ensure the guidelines set out by our Government, the Auto Cycle Union, Circuit Owners and NG Road Racing are being followed. Anyone continually not behaving in accordance with those guidelines will be asked to leave the venue.
- 9. If you or any of your social bubble/team/family develop symptoms of Covid 19 while at the venue, you must all leave the venue immediately. It is important you notify NG Road Racing via phone/text about your situation. The numbers are: Race Office 07580 094577 or Steve Bostock 07967 681639. Leave a message if there is no answer. Do not under any circumstances visit any office on site, you must not visit the Medical Centre.**
- 10. If you or any of your social bubble/team/family develop symptoms of Covid 19 during the lead up to the event, i.e within 10 days - you must not attend. Notify NG Road Racing of your situation immediately and you will be given a full race entry refund.**
