Directions to the Circuit.

Castle Combe is situated in Wiltshire near J17 / J18 of the M4 and approx. 5 miles from Chippenham on the B4039. Look out for the brown chequered flag signs. **Sat Nav: SN14 7EY**

What's on track.

Saturday sees morning warm-up followed by all-important timed qualifying as the riders compete for that coveted pole position, followed by the first round of championship races.

Sunday has warm-up followed by two sets of championship races.

Each championship race sees 25 points going to the winner, right down to 1 point for tenth place.

That's 30 championship finals over the two days of racing to enjoy.
