



Technical Inspection procedure at NG Road Racing events until further notice

Technical Inspection of competitors motorcycles and race attire remains mandatory at our events. This document outlines the new procedure for Technical Inspection and should be followed as closely as practicably possible.

- Only the rider must present their machine for Technical Inspection, wearing full race attire, carrying their crash helmet. **Face masks are mandatory** while queuing and during your inspection. No one else should be present from your family or team. The only exception to this are competitors under the age of 18 who must be accompanied throughout all administration processes.
- **You must bring your Individual Idemnity form pre signed, with you to Technical Inspection.** The Technical staff will need to place a sticker on the top of your form to prove you have passed through the Technical Inspection process.
- When called forward for your inspection, you should sit on your machine and follow the instructions of the Technical staff.
- Upon completion of your machine inspection, you will move forward to a second area where you will be asked to remove your face mask and put your crash helmet on. A visual check of your race attire will be made at this time.
- Once complete, a member of the Technical staff will place a sticker on your machine, crash helmet and on your Individual Idemnity (pre signed – signing on) form.
- You should then leave the Technical Inspection area as soon as possible.
- If either your machine or any item of race attire fails the inspection, you should re present the failed item as soon as possible once the issue is rectified. Again, **you must wear your face mask at all times** while in or around the Technical Area.
- Remember to bring your Individual Idemnity form with you for your re inspection.
- Once Technical Inspection is complete, you should take your Individual Idemnity form and Race License to the Race Office. **Face Masks must be worn while queuing and upon entry to the Race Office.**

Notes:

Paddock stands will not be required for Technical Inspection. This is to reduce the “footfall” in and around the area as a 2nd family/team member will often have to carry the stand separately from the machine.

Please respect the Officials and staff at all times. They are working under increased pressure and also have new processes and protocols to work to.
