125GP National & 250GP ACU National Championships

Championship Conditions

Version 2.1 February 2021

Eligibility: Open to current road race license holders, who are paid up members of NG Road Racing Club. Minimum age is 14 years old for all categories detailed below

Classes: 125 GP National Championship: Open to riders of all license grades on any 125GP two stroke prototype machine.

250GP ACU National Championship: Open to all entrants of all license grades on 250/350GP two stroke prototype machines.

250GP NG Cup: Open to Newcomer and Clubman license holders on 250/350GP two stroke prototype machines. The NG Cup is also open to National license holders on 250/350GP two stroke prototype machines manufactured up to and including 1999 (Honda RS250 up to and including 2000).

TSGP members: All riders registered with the 2 stroke GP Series (TSGP Club) are eligible for the above categories. TSGP Club conditions, awards and categories apply in addition to these conditions.

All riders that enter the NG Cup and TSGP classes will automatically be included in the 250GP ACU National Championship.

Races will incorporate a separate Championship for 250GP 4 Strokes: (Moto3/Moto Star/British Talent Cup)

Championships - The winner of the National Championships shall be crowned:

- (250) **250GP ACU National Champion**
- (125) **125GP National Champion**
- (250) **250GP NG Cup Champion**
- (4 stroke) **Moto3 National Champion**

One day event format -

- 1 x free practice
- 1 x qualifying session for 15 minutes (TQ)
- 1 x Championship race approx 20 miles. Full points trophies and prize money awarded

Two day event format - Day 1 -

- 1 x free practice
- 1 x qualifying session for 15 minutes (TQ)
- 1 x Championship race approx 20 miles. Full points, trophies and prize money awarded

Day 2 -

- 1 x free practice (Warm Up)
- Race 2 sprint race. Grid from fastest lap from race 1 day 1. Lap times for this race will determine grid positions for feature race later in day. Full points and trophies awarded.
- Race 3, Championship race approx 20 miles. Full points, trophies and prize money awarded.



Flags - Blue flags will be used for this series. All other flags will be used in accordance with the current ACU handbook

Tyres - Any tyres are permitted in accordance with the current ACU handbook

Fuel - In accordance with the current ACU handbook

Cost - Registration/club membership fee is £25.00 available on-line at www.ngroadracing.org
ENTER AS EARLY AS YOU ARE ABLE.

Entries: £200.00 for 2 day events. £140.00 for 1 day events.

Scottish, Irish, Channel Isles and non UK residents i.e. mainland Europe, entry fee is £130.00 for 2 day events, £100 for 1 day events. NG Reserve the right to challenge or refuse discounts if a permanent place of residence cannot be proved.

Event entries are available on-line at www.ngroadracing.org Payment is taken normally around 10 days prior to each event.

Prizes - Points for all races will be awarded as follows 25 - 1st, 20, 16, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 - 15th

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions in both 125GP and 250GP, plus the top 3 in all class Championships at the end of the year. NG Cup and Moto3 winners will receive a trophy.

NG Road Racing reserve the right to alter or amend awards presented if the entry levels are deemed insufficient. A podium ceremony / photo shoot, will take place immediately after the "afternoon" race, i.e. Races 1 and 3. Prize money will be paid on Saturdays race and the 2nd race on Sunday to 1st 2nd and 3rd positions in the 250GP National Championship.

TSGP will award points and prize money based on aggregate weekend performances rather than race by race. (see separate TSGP Club conditions) Award presentations will take place separately to the post race podiums.

250GP ACU Championship winners shall be required to attend the ACU National Presentation evening (date tbc) to receive the official National Championship Trophy

Championship sponsors: Graphics showing series sponsors must be displayed if instructed. It is the responsibility of NG Road Racing to supply the graphics.
